

Catherine Mohr Scholarship

Objective

The Catherine Mohr Scholarship is designed to remove barriers so adult learners who do not have any financial assistance from an organization (excluding federal financial aid) can continue their educational goals. This scholarship will pay the tuition and fees for the Entrance Seminar the very first session an adult learner attends Southwestern College Professional Studies. Scholarship awards will be made twice a year during the third session of the spring and fall semesters.

Requirements/Selection Criteria

- Learners must be seeking their first baccalaureate degree.
- Learners must complete all admission requirements and be admitted to Southwestern College Professional Studies. (Refer to website for admission requirements – www.southwesterncollege.org)
- Learners must have earned a minimum of 30 college-level credit hours with at least a 2.0 GPA before applying for entrance into Southwestern College Professional Studies; it is preferable that learners enter with an AA, AS, AGS, AOS, or AAS degree but is not required.
- Learners must submit a Catherine Mohr Scholarship application, a typed one-page personal statement (between 500-750 words) that includes long term goals, unique experiences, financial need, or additional information the committee should take into consideration, and copies of unofficial transcripts from all previously attended colleges.
- Learners who are eligible for tuition assistance from an employer/military/VA or other organization (not including federal financial aid) are not eligible to receive this scholarship.
- The Catherine Mohr Scholarship award will cover the tuition and technology fees (excluding books) for the Entrance Seminar (HRD 210) and is applicable only to the first session of the learners' education at Southwestern College.
- The Catherine Mohr Scholarship award is non-renewable.
- Scholarships will be awarded twice a year during the third session of the spring and fall semesters (March-April and November – December).
