### TESTING PROCEDURES FOR CLEP EXAMS

1. All exams will be administered at our Wichita West Center: 3460 N Ridge Rd, Suite 50
2. To schedule a testing session, please contact the test administrator 3-4 days prior to the preferred test date to confirm the date and time.
3. Exams may be scheduled Monday-Thursday, 10:00am through 4:00pm.
4. On the day of the examination, you must bring the following items:
  - Photo identification
  - Do NOT bring books, papers, alarm watch, pagers, cell phones OR children!
  - TEST FEE AND TEST ADMINISTRATION FEES (see below)
5. FEES: effective **July 1, 2010**:
  - \$77.00 per test (allowed methods of payment: credit or debit card (preferred method), check or money order made payable to "CLEP")
  - Test Administration Fee (payable by check only):
    - Southwestern College Students: \$10.00
    - Non-Southwestern College Students: \$20.00
